



#### **OVERVIEW & HISTORY**

peration Home Cooking (OHC) is an initiative developed through the collaboration and support of the spouses of our nation's senior military leaders to recognize the commitment and sacrifices our military spouses and caregivers make every day caring for their families and supporting their service members. OHC takes place each year during the DC Metropolitan Cooking and Entertaining Show (MCES) at the Washington Convention Center. Admittance to OHC is free for military spouses, including those whose service members are currently deployed and those who have lost their service member while serving our country, as well spouses and caregivers for Wounded Warriors recuperating from combat injuries.

Over the past four years, OHC has honored more than 7,000 military spouses by providing them a day of culinary fun and fellowship at MCES. The inaugural event honoring 300 spouses, held on November 13, 2010, included cooking demonstrations by Food Network celebrity chefs Paula Deen and Bobby Flay and a surprise visit from Dr. Jill Biden. At our 2012 event, Giada De Laurentiis guided a crew of spouses in the preparation of several of her signature dishes

as she took questions from the audience and Admiral Sandy Winnefeld, Vice Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, returned for a second year to assist as guest chef and prepared his famous paella recipe!


